School Based Moderation

School based moderation takes place once a semester, towards the end of the reporting period. Teachers bring samples of student work and assessment results. Teachers use this time to professionally judge student achievement and monitor continuity across the year level and school.

Throughout the year, teachers engage in moderation with others on an unofficial basis. Teachers discuss student work, assessment items and testing results to ensure consistency across each year level and the school.

Year 2 Net Moderation

Year 1-3 teachers are involved with the Year 2 Diagnostic Net moderation each year. Teachers moderate work samples with other teachers in the area from other schools. Samples of student work then go to a District Moderation and is moderated with all schools in the Mackay – Whitsunday region.

QCAR Moderation

Queens Beach School has been a trial school for the QCAR tasks for the last 2 years. In 2008, all schools will participate in the QCAR tasks. During this process, teachers are involved with moderation of student work at a school and at a regional level.
